Absences

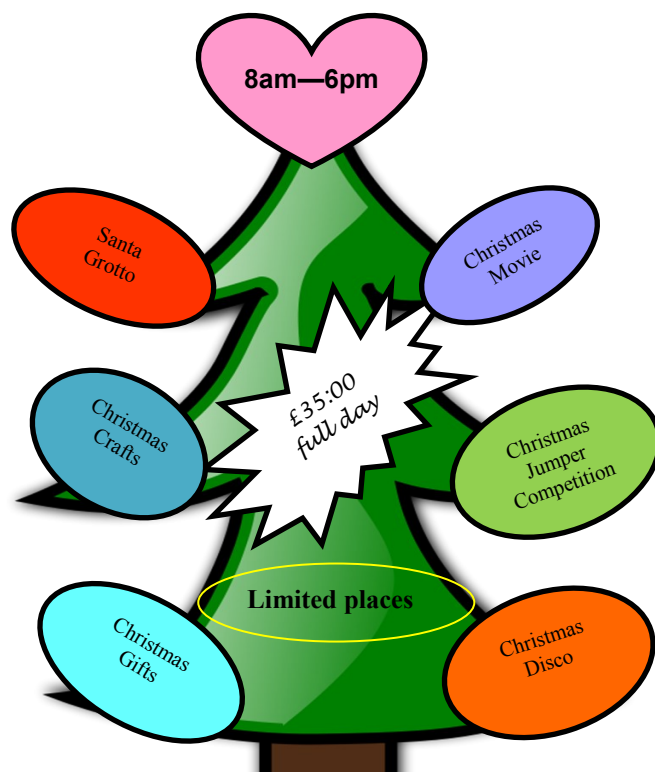
If your child is absent from school we ask that you please phone by 10.00am or an unauthorised absence will be recorded.
